

IEEE Section Corporate Outstanding Engineer Award

A. Description:

The "Corporate Outstanding Engineer Award" is designed to recognize members of the Twin Cities Section who through their technical abilities have made outstanding and noteworthy contributions to their employer. It recognizes the development of new technical concepts, significant patents, development of new devices, development of applications, new designs, significant cost reductions using known techniques, etc..

B. Eligibility:

1. Nominees shall be a member of the Twin Cities Section.

C. Criteria for Consideration:

The primary consideration of the award shall be the recommendation of the Nominee's employer.

D. Award Presentation:

1. The "Corporate Outstanding Engineer Award" shall be prepared by the Nominee's employer and be of such a format as determined by the Nominee's employer.
The presentation of the award shall be made by a representative of the Nominee's employer at the annual Twin Cities Section Award Banquet.

E. Nomination Procedure:

1. A nominator shall be the employer of a member within the Twin Cities Section.
Nominations shall be submitted to the Twin Cities Section Award Committee by Jan 31 for presentation of the award at the Twin Cities Section Awards Banquet in Feb.
